The hotel has a large 40 item breakfast buffet, which is included. All rooms have a refrigerator and a microwave. An inside and outside pool and hot tub are on the premises, so bring your bathing suits. A piano is in the lobby, hope someone in our group can play for us.

After checking into the hotel we will head over to The Dixie Stampede for dinner and a show. After the show we will have a step-on guide take us on a tour of the "Christmas Lights" of Pigeon Forge and Gatlinburg.

Day 2 - We will enjoy the breakfast buffet and head over to see the Blackwood's morning show. Our next stop will be the Christmas Shop, maybe get us in the Spirit. Lunch will be on your own at Walden's Landing, they have several restaurants and shops and are in walking distance of our hotel. You probably will want a light lunch after the large breakfast.
